

HOUSE RULES

To be given to each Group Leader on arrival

PLEASE READ ON /BEFORE ARRIVAL

- 1 There is an absolute ban on smoking, by any person, in the Dormitory Areas,** which include the *Family Quarters* and *Crew Quarters*. Smoking is not allowed in the T.V. Room, Corridors, Dining Room or Kitchen.
- 2 Under no circumstances is alcohol to be brought into the centre.** Anybody coming into the Centre under the influence will be asked to leave and will be banned from the Centre.
- 3 Dormitories are for sleeping in.** They are not to be used as games rooms i.e. using the beds as trampolines, playing ball etc. The Dormitories must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- 4 Please ensure your group sleep in their allocated area(s).** Under no circumstances move beds from one room to another.
- 5 Breakages and damages will be billed to groups responsible for them.** Please report any facilities or equipment *out of order* to the Warden.
- 6 The Fire Alarm is for the safety of everybody using the Centre and must not be interfered with.** Use only in emergency. Please stay off Fire Escapes – they are also only for emergency evacuation.
- 7 Please report any /all accidents, no matter how minor, to the Warden,** who will then record it in the 'Accident Report Book'.
- 8 Only soft balls to be used in the house.** We have sports gear which you can use.
- 9 Areas in the Centre will be assigned to your group for cleaning** – this is apart from your dormitories.
- 10 Please Note: Leaders are responsible for the supervision and care of the Scouts /Guides at all times.** Leaders must sleep in the Leader Bedroom assigned to them near their Scouts. Leaders must also be with their Scouts while staying in the Centre. *All members of every group* must wear their troop neckerchief at all times.
- 11 Lights Out, Quiet and Lock-Up must be observed by everybody** – time; 12.30 a.m.
- 12 The Scout Centre reserves the right to expel any person** if, in the opinion of the Warden, their behaviour gives cause for concern.
